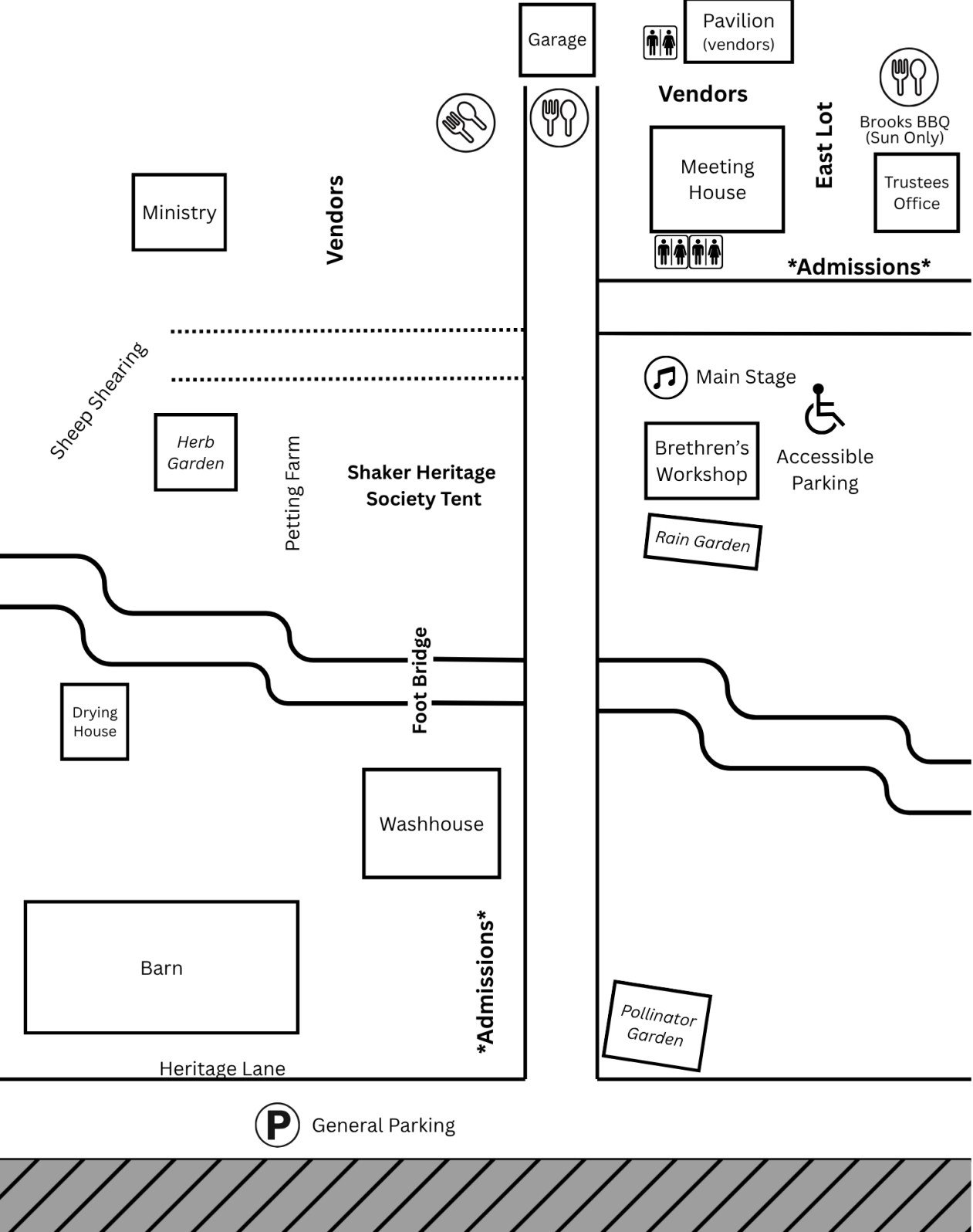

The Shaker Heritage Society enriches the Capital Region by engaging the community with the founding home and enduring values of the Shakers.

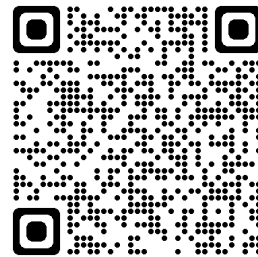
**The Watervliet Shaker community was America's first Shaker settlement, established in 1776.** The Watervliet Shakers' core beliefs included the equality of men and women and of all races, pacifism, communalism, and celibacy. Ever industrious, they developed the process of packaging garden seeds in small paper envelopes and invented the flat broom. These two products, along with medicinal herbs, grew into major industries. Shakers here also impacted changes in New York State laws governing divorce, child custody, and property ownership.

**Shaker Heritage Society** is a nonprofit education and historic preservation organization. SHS resides on a recognized National Historic District. The SHS complex includes 9 historic structures, an herb garden, and apple orchard. The site is a short walk away from the Shaker Cemetery, Albany County's Ann Lee Pond Preserve, and the Albany International Airport.
